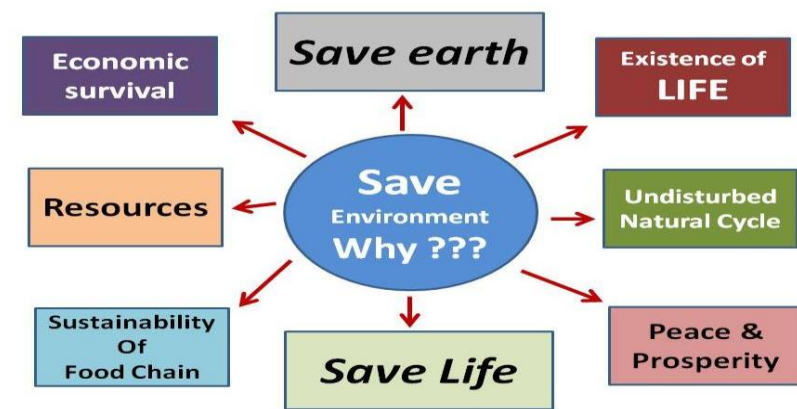

Abstract, related to the seminar theme and subthemes, should be of minimum 250 words and not more than 400 words, typed either in Hindi or English language. The font used in English should be **Times New Roman (font size 12)**, and in Hindi it should be **DevLys 010 (Font size 13)**.

The same font size is required to get the full paper typed in English or Hindi language, as applicable. The full paper should be of minimum 2500 words and maximum 4000 words, with proper source/references. Both abstract and full paper must be sent in the seminar e-mail till the dates, as mentioned overleaf.

The selected papers will be published in an edited volume with ISBN No. and by National level publisher. The selection of papers will be the sole right of the organizers.
